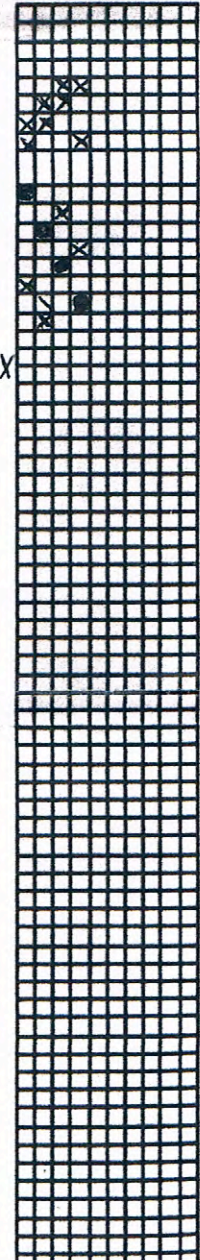
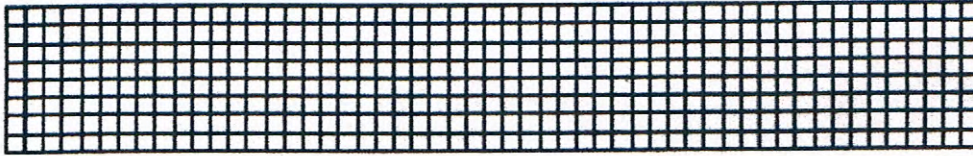
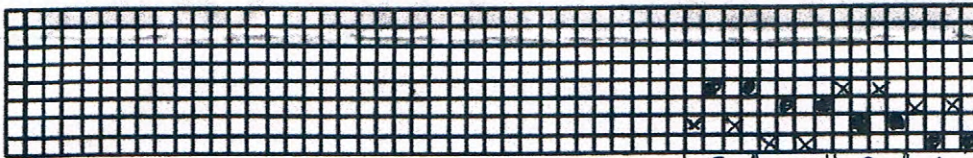

Warp: 8/2 Cotton in yellow, Red, green, & Purple ■ X

Weft: 8/2 Cotton in yellow or green  
Black sewing thread

Reed: 10 Sley: 4 Sett: 40 EPI

Notes:  
floating selvedges are nice for this. Be careful weft doesn't get too loose. Two blocks must always weave together

threaded (D block, C Block, B Block, A Block, B Block, C Block, D Block) X 2

treadled A & B, B & C, C & D, B & C, A & B

Blocks are threaded with 2 colors; ■ is one color and X is the other
