Barbara: spinning with a bamboo/angelica combination.

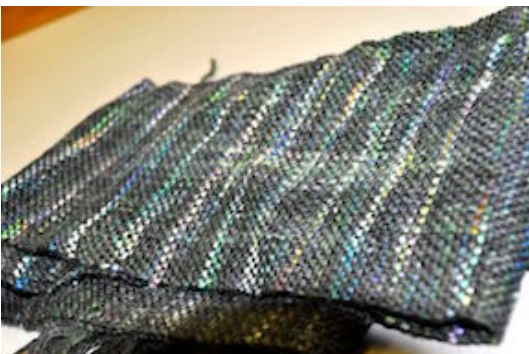
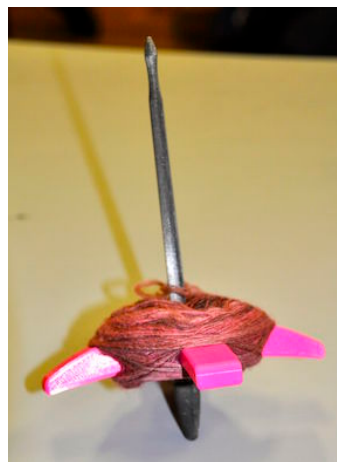
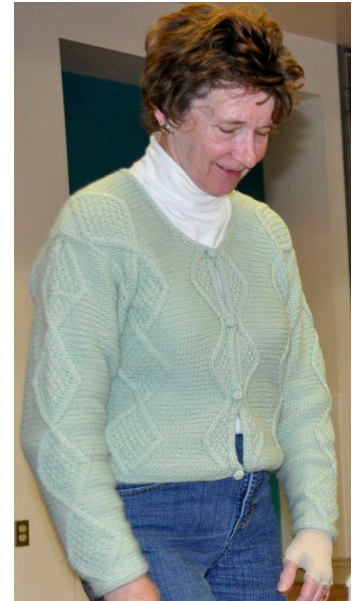
