Refurbishing Your Loom Heddle bars: steel wool any rust off the heddle bars, then wipe with Howard Feed N Wax. Wood: Use Murphy's Oil Soap to clean; let dry 2-3 days; coat with Howard Feed N Wax. If it moves, wax it. Use paraffin to lubricate the loom ends of harnesses. Reeds: some reeds can be repaired, but not the kind with the taped top and bottom. If the apron smells a bit musty, use a Febreeze type product.
