Guild members will work on the MAFA 2015 Conference exhibit "Favorite fibers and what we are doing with them" at the January Super Bash. Marsha will come up with possible visuals.

A Nominating Committee, composed of Jane, Judy and Debbie, will draw up a proposed slate of officers for 2015, to be voted on at the December meeting. Officers are: President, Vice President/Program Chairman, Secretary and Treasurer.

Old Business:

The education sub-committee met after the August meeting. They decided to come up with "lesson plans" for several simple, hands-on programs that the Guild could advertise by word of mouth, on the website and at the Farmers Market in October.

Marsha is contacting Hospice House about possible donations of handwoven items. The Guild is especially interested in doing something in memory of Frankie Snipes.

Ingrid brought in Guild-owned "display shawls". Possibilities for dispersing them include giving them to members who originally worked on them, selling them to interested guild members, and selling them at the Heathsville Farmers Market.
