A motion was made and seconded to accept the minutes of the July meeting as published in the August newsletter. The motion passed unanimously.

Topics include advancing twills, my approach to network drafted twills, advancing point twills, special tie-ups, and ways to weave these threadings as overshot, lace, and furrowed fabrics."
