Hello Marsha and Williamsburg Spinners & Weavers,

Yes, I've been slowing down in getting new issues published. However, new subscriptions and renewals continue to come, and I began to feel the weight of all the issues I owed subscribers.

So I announced on the back cover of Issue 30 that I will no longer accept new subscriptions and renewals. The last issue I am promising to publish will be Issue 32 (although I may do more if I feel like it).

I have postponed updating the website to allow people to subscribe starting with Issue 29 and expiring with Issue 32. (Issue 30 is the current issue, which I send along with Issue 29.)

When I update the website in a few weeks, the subscriptions and renewals will go away. All the back issues will continue to be available through the website and retail stores around the country--the only change will be no more subscriptions.

When I publish a new issue, I'll put a photo of the front cover on the opening page of the website, making it easy to check occasionally to see whether you have the current issue.

In the meantime, subscribers with subscriptions expiring past Issue 32 are welcome to substitute a back issue for each one or request a refund.
