

**Photo show and tell!** Donna spoke so well to our guild, we had to post her as our frontispiece.










Our guest speaker Donna Wynn, from VA Beach, showed many fabulous adventures she has experienced with her tapestry journey!

She Sent a photo of her Dryad loom from England. Donna calls her Phoebe.

Our Kris has been weaving and knitting. The green and grey Tabby napkins she wove at 16 epi, using 8/2 cotton. The houndstooth scarf she wove on her rigid heddle loom. And the knitted cable hat was given as gifts, like the weavings. Graceful.









Cindy experimented with gold and rust 8/2 cotton doubled in her color and weave project. Amazing on the rigid heddle loom! Kathy wove 2 baby blankets in soft neutrals with pink and green strips. Precious! She also experimented with Josephine Estes miniature overshot. Ingrid created socks from her knitting machine! So Cool...
